New Staff

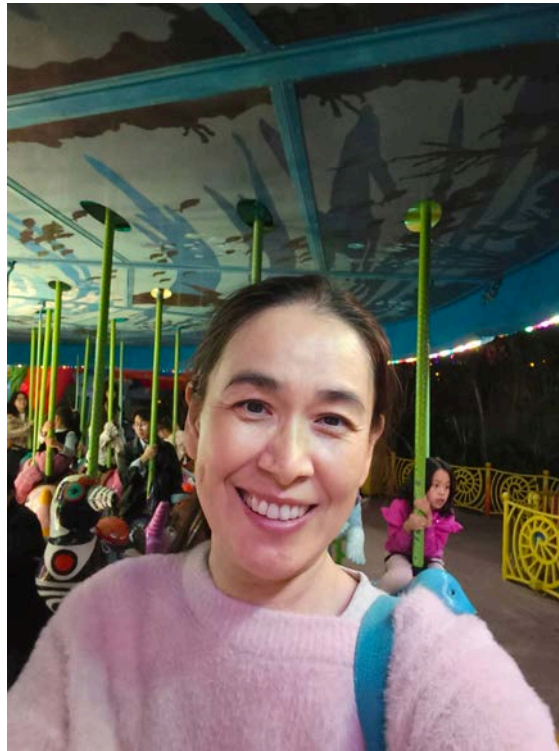
