They journeyed through the solar system to discover how the Earth's rotation and tilt on its axis create the changing seasons and affect our daily lives. In this safe, stadium-style theatre, our students watched spectacular, high-voltage demonstrations. The highlight was the giant Tesla coil, generating massive three-metre lightning bolts right before their eyes. Everyone learned fascinating facts about static electricity and crucial lightning safety. Beyond the shows, our students explored a variety of interactive, STEM-focused spaces.
